November 4, 2021

Special called meeting of the Monroe County Board of Elections for the purpose of reviewing Provisional Ballots cast during the November 2, 2021 Election.

There were three Provisional Votes cast during the November 2 election:

It was noted that Chris Hewett had won the only contested race in the Municipal Election and that the TSPLOST was approved by a vote of 1367 to 930.
