MINUTES

June 14, 2021

Meeting was called to order and was opened with prayer.

The minutes of the May 10th meeting were reviewed and approved as printed.

The Expenditure Analysis was reviewed with nothing of note. The need to meet with the County Finance Director was again mentioned.

Warren and Harbuck reported that Board members, Harbuck and Bennett, and staff members, Warren and Dumas, attended the June 9th meeting of the Culloden City Council to discuss with them the November Municipal elections and the county wide T SPLOST referendum. After a brief discussion the Council voted to combine the municipal election ballot with the T SPLOST ballot. This will allow the voters in Culloden to have only one ballot for the November election.

The Chair suggested the possibility of cancelling the July 12 Board meeting since at this time there does not appear that there will be anything needing Board attention. The Board agreed to the cancellation with the understanding that if necessary a meeting would be called.

Election Update: Qualifying for the November Forsyth Municipal Election will be August 16-20.
